**GREEN BAY, Wis. — January 2, 2008** — Single working mother of three and soon-to-be Habitat for Humanity homeowner Jennifer Nissen knows firsthand what a difference a helping hand can make. So do Ryan and Angie Cropper, whose 2-year-old daughter and 6-year-old son are hippotherapy patients of Exceptional Equestrians, which provides educational and therapeutic riding instruction for people with special needs of all ages.
