First-Ever American Sleep Apnea Association Award Given to Nation's Largest Truckload Carrier

"The drivers we determined to be 'high risk', based upon a prescreen questionnaire, were provided with a treatment program. This approach has greatly improved the overall health of these drivers, reduced our healthcare benefits costs and delivered a 30 percent reduction in accident frequency due to driver fatigue."

Schneider National accepted the ASAA award at the American Trucking Association's Safety and Human Resources National Conference and Exhibition in Pittsburgh, Penn., on September 21, 2007.
